

8TH GRADE END OF THE YEAR ACTIVITIES

5. Any student with excessive detentions and/or Saturday School detentions.
6. Administrative decision based on the discretion of the school Principal.

Medical Conditions - Students with medical conditions must get clearance in writing from a doctor and must be accompanied on the trip by a parent or guardian.
